



2.2.1 The institution assesses students' learning levels and organises special programmes for both slow and advanced learners

The institution assesses the learning levels of the students, after their admission and organizes special Programmes in other to distinguish them according to their learning abilities and term them as advanced learners and slow learners.

Induction Day:

The institution organizes a induction programme for new joining fresher's to facilitate them with the basics of the degree, in which the Principal, respective Heads of the various Departments and Teachers interact with the Parents and Students, giving them a brief overview of the degree. An interactive environment is created which helps to assess the knowledge of students according to their interests.

Special orientation is conducted to the students who are admitted into different Engineering Courses where they get to acknowledge Course Structure, Exam pattern and overall vision of course is introduced which helps and enable them to cope up with the syllabus of the course.

Slow learners:

When compared to schools there is a change in the teaching environment and the pattern college's follow, due to which students sometime find it difficult to cope up and grasp the subjects especially at the starting of their college I.e in their first semester.

Strategies for slow learners:

- Tutorials / remedial classes are conducted for these students to explain the critical topics, to clarify their doubts as to foster improvement in their academic performance.
- We keep a close eye on students' attendance, and we'll notify parents of students who are often absent or tardy through SMS or phone call. in order to encourage them to routinely attend the classes.
- Along with helping them succeed academically, we encourage students to take an active role in all of their extracurricular activities.




- For every 20 students, one of our faculty members is assigned as a mentor or counselor; they regularly engage with the students in friendly interactions and assist them in resolving their individual issues and achieving their objectives.
- Assigning regular homework is an essential part of our teaching approach for slow learners because they give students the opportunity to practice and revise their understanding of the subject on their own, resulting in a complete understanding of the subject.

Advanced learners:

Advanced learners are those who are really good at problem solving and also perform well in their mid examinations, they are identified and the following strategies are performed.

Strategies for Advanced Learners:

- Bright students are those who excel at problem-solving and also perform well on midterm exams; these students are identified and the following strategies are used.
- Students are encouraged to join professional organizations such as IEEE, IETE, and ISTE in order to advance their overall skills.
- They are put to the test with a variety of tasks and assignments in order to improve their performance and skills.
- Based on performance and talents demonstrated within classroom, a class representative is chosen for each class. The class representative assumes responsible for organizing departmental seminars and workshops that provide opportunities for interaction with academic and professional specialists.
- They are motivated in taking internships in industries that are related to their core subjects.


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
