- > During the program every student is encouraged to choose one skill related to arts, painting, sculpture, pottery, music, dance etc. to develop a sense of aesthetics and also to enhance creativity
- Creative Arts Universal Human Values module will help The students are encouraged to develop Universal Human Values which help them to explore oneself and experience the joy of learning, stand up to peer pressure, take decisions with courage, create awareness about the relationship with colleagues and supporting staff in the hostel and department,

- ➤ It is best achieved through Group Discussions (GD) debating, enacting a play in small groups of about 20 students with a faculty mentor each. The faculty from all departments are involved in this activity.
- > Lectures by eminent people, who are socially active are invited to familiarize the students in those particular areas.
- > The students are taken for a Visit to the local area to understand the society.
- ➤ The students are made to visit their respective departments, laboratories, workshops & other facilities to get the information in advance about the facilities available in the institution.

It helps in nurturing their character essentially by which they would understand their role as an engineer, a citizen and a human being. STUDENT INDUCTION PROGRAM

The aim of induction is to set up to generate well trained engineers with a feeling of responsibility towards oneself, one's family, and society. Many students are influenced by their parents and society to take engineering course without proper understanding of their own interests and talents, most students fail to link up with their goals. Students come with diverse thoughts, backgrounds and preparations. It is important to assist them adjust in the new environment and inculcate in them the ethos of the institution with a sense of larger purpose. —

Before the commencement of normal classes the students are given induction for 3 weeks. Its purpose is to make the students feel comfortable in their new environment, set a healthy daily routine, create bonding in the batch as well as between faculty, develop awareness, sensitivity and understanding of the self, society at large, and nature The Induction Program helps the students to inculcate and acclimatize themselves for technical education. It is designed to make the newly joined students feel comfortable, sensitize them towards exploring their academic interests and activities, reducing competition and inspire them work for excellence, promote bonding within them, build relations between teachers and students. It aims to have a broader perspective of life in building character.

The following are the activities under the induction program in which the student should be fully and actively engaged throughout the program.

- > During the program every student is encouraged to choose one skill related to arts, painting, sculpture, pottery, music, dance etc. to develop a sense of aesthetics and also to enhance creativity
- Creative Arts Universal Human Values module will help The students are encouraged to develop Universal Human Values which help them to explore oneself and experience the joy of learning, stand up to peer pressure, take decisions with courage, create awareness about the relationship with colleagues and supporting staff in the hostel and department,

- ➤ It is best achieved through Group Discussions (GD) debating, enacting a play in small groups of about 20 students with a faculty mentor each. The faculty from all departments are involved in this activity.
- > Lectures by eminent people, who are socially active are invited to familiarize the students in those particular areas.
- > The students are taken for a Visit to the local area to understand the society.
- ➤ The students are made to visit their respective departments, laboratories, workshops & other facilities to get the information in advance about the facilities available in the institution.

Thus the induction program helps the graduating students how to develop knowledge and their skills in their core areas. It helps in nurturing their character essentially by which they would understand their role as an engineer, a citizen and a human being. Besides this the newly joined students feel comfortable and get ready to work for excellence, build relations between teachers and students.
