

- The students are made to visit their respective departments, laboratories, workshops & other facilities to get the information in advance about the facilities available in the institution.

It helps in nurturing their character essentially by which they would understand their role as an engineer, a citizen and a human being. Besides this the newly joined students feel comfortable and get ready to work for excellence, build relations between teachers and students.
