

• Community Tree Planting: Organize events to plant trees on campus or in the surrounding community, enhancing green spaces and promoting biodiversity.


5. Sustainable Transportation Initiatives

10. Sustainability Challenges


- 30-Day Sustainability Challenge: Encourage students and staff to adopt one sustainable practice each day for a month and share their experiences.
