AND

Movate Private Limited, a company registered under the Companies Act, 1956 and having its registered office at 6th Floor, 32A&B, Ambit IT Park, Ambit IT Park Road, Ambattur Industrial Estate, Chennai – 600058, Tamil Nadu, India, hereinafter referred to as "Movate" / "Second Party", which expression shall where the context so admits includes its successors in interest and permitted assigns.

Hereinafter referred to jointly as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party" to this MOU.

WHEREAS

VAAGDEVI COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, (the "College") stands out as an institute of academic excellence by imparting technical, intellectual, and professional skills to the students, offers a distinguishing blend of post graduate, undergraduate and research programs.

Movate is a global Information Technology, Consulting and Digital Solutions company that provides IT and business consulting, application support and maintenance, development, systems integration, and managed services to its customers.

The College is desirous of placing its students in Movate through campus placement.

Movate is desirous of identifying and nurturing suitable talent from the College who will be considered for placement to Movate after graduation.

This MOU is intended to be legally binding between the Parties and is enforceable in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations.

Accordingly, the Parties have decided to reduce into writing their mutual representations and understanding as stated hereunder:



NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

Objective:

The over-all objective of this MOU is to ensure:

- 1. Students of the College who meet the eligibility criteria of Movate are trained on the latest cutting-edge technology of interest for Movate.
- 2. Placement opportunities for the students in Movate upon successful completion of training as per defined threshold.
- 3. Faculty development through structured "Train the Trainer Program" and "Certification" by Movate Subject Matter Experts.
- 4. Trained and ready to deploy talent availability for Movate.
- 5. Curriculum Integration and industry relevant academic curriculum.
- 6. Movate representatives to be in Board of Studies of College to guide and mentor the students in developing talent and make them industry ready.
- 7. Provide opportunities to students to be groomed and mentored by industry experts
- 8. Curriculum Integration and design certificate programs for the students.
- 9. Launch credit courses for the students to gain experience in the latest technology domain.
 - 1. The Parties on this day have executed this MOU to establish a partnership with an intention to enhance the capability of the students selected for Movate from the College through guidance on industry requisite courses, focus training for the pre-selected students through the College faculty that will be trained by Movate and other industry academia collaboration between the Parties subject to the following Terms and Conditions:
 - a. The college can choose to partner with Movate on the specific technology domain specified as per Annexure 4
 - b. The Program Sponsors for the agreed programs shall be the Head of Training & Placement Department from the College and Head Campus and Institutional Alliance from Movate.
 - c. The 4th year students of BE / B Tech Engineering course who are to be trained shall be pre-selected by Movate (hereinafter referred to as the "Pre-selected Students") as per Movate's selection process and a Letter of Intent (LOI) will be given to the Pre-selected Students which will specify the conditions to be complied with to join the organization.
 - d. The pre-selection of students is primarily for the Graduate Engineer Trainee (GET) category.
 - e. Top performing students from the training program who qualify may be selected into Movate roles, subject to the policies of Movate. Movate will have the final call based on the individual performance of the students in this regard. All final selections for offer will be subject to selection in the final Movate recruitment process.
 - f. Movate will provide the College with training curriculum, connect with Movate's training partners for learning contents and assessments, industry-academia exposure, and support events to uplift the capability of the Pre-selected Students. The College shall use the materials, procure at its own cost necessary software and program manage these efforts under the guidance of designated representative of Movate and exclusively for the purpose specified under this MOU.
 - g. The College shall nominate two or three faculty members per domain for undergoing the Trainer Certification Program by Movate. The objective of this program is to train the College faculty on specific modules as per the program chosen and equip them to manage the training completion by



students, support in conducting assessments and act as a key member in supporting the overall program delivery in the College. Upon successful completion of the training the faculty would be certified by Movate and will be allowed to train certain number of students as agreed upon in writing by Movate and the College from time to time.

- h. The College shall, at its own cost and expenses, establish a Center of Excellence (CoE) under the guidance of Movate with the specified infrastructure requirements of Movate and shall use the CoE for imparting the CoE specific course/training. This CoE shall be exclusive to the use of the purpose stated under this MOU and will not be used for running or the courses of the College or other organizations. Kindly refer Annexure 2 for the hardware and software requirement for the CoE.
- i. Refer **Annexure-1: Campus Connect Collaboration Plan** is a list of recommended programs by Movate which aims to make the Pre-selected Students industry ready. Movate recommended programs will be implemented for the Pre-selected Students.
- j. The Pre-selected Students in their 7th Semester, will have to complete the Foundation course consisting of both soft skills and technical Skills. On successful completion of the course, they will undergo a specialized training identified by Movate for the College and obtain their certification in their 8thSemester.
- k. The College shall not charge the Pre-selected Students any fee for this course. If it is found that the College has charged fees for this program from students, Movate shall have the rights to terminate this MOU and/or pursue other remedies available under the law, against the College.
- The College shall not train any students other than the Movate Pre-selected Students using the know-how and resources made available by Movate and its partners under this Agreement. The College shall ensure and commit that all Pre-selected Students undergoing the programs under this MOU, do not sit through the campus selection process of any other company. Any of the Pre-selected Students who is not made an offer by Movate in the final selection is free to apply to any other company.
- m. Movate would do an initial screening process and shortlist students for the CoE program. The shortlisted students, would be given a conditional offer letter (Letter of Intent-LOI), confirming their selection into the program.
- n. Movate shall have the discretion to make full time employment offers to any of the Pre-selected Students upon successful selection in Movate's recruitment process, subject to completion of their graduation. Movate shall not be under obligation under this MOU to recruit any fixed number of Preselected Students.
- o. The program involves substantial efforts and investment and continuous engagement from Movate with the intent to develop and hire substantial number of students from the College. The College shall therefore take all necessary steps to ensure that atleast 90% of the pre-selected Students join Movate after successful completion of the training. A drop in the joining percentage below the expected level will seriously jeopardize Movate's interests and may be a material reason to not continue the engagement in the following years.
- 2. This MoU is subject to the College earmarking a minimum of 15 students/program for placement in Movate exclusively and the College meeting the qualification and past performance criteria defined by Movate (Ranking in either of the following: NIRF, Career 360, NBA & NAAC(A). The shortlisted students to the program(s) should not be made available for placement opportunities with other organizations that might come up in the college campus later.
- 3. The MOU shall be valid for three (3) years from the date of execution. Movate shall have the right to terminate this MOU for convenience and in the event of breach of material obligations including



confidentiality obligations by the College by giving a notice of fifteen (15) days, provided that the breach is not remedied by the College within such period.

- 4. The Parties herein have agreed to perform various obligations for the purpose outlined in the MOU and there is no monetary obligation/consideration involved herein between the Parties. The College shall bear all expenses towards providing infrastructure, network and internet access, other facilities required for the education and training and such other expenses incurred in performing its obligations under this MOU.
- 5. The Confidential Information includes, but is not limited to, any information, course material, plans, discussions, strategies or any material provided by Movate or its partners to the College, and Movate's technology including discoveries, inventions, research and development efforts, manufacturing processes, hardware/ software (regardless of media) design and maintenance tools and hardware/software product know-how, which may be disclosed by Movate to the College during the subsistence of this MOU. Confidential Information shall also include any information marked "Confidential" or "Proprietary" but does not include any information already in the public domain or such information which was obtained from a third party. The College shall not disclose, reproduce, and use any Confidential Information for any purpose except solely in connection with the performance of this MOU. Upon expiration or termination of this MOU, the College shall cease using all such Confidential Information and it shall either destroy or return all copies of such Confidential Information, in whatever form. The College and any of its personnel/ students/ faculty shall not disclose the Confidential Information during the term of this MOU and thereafter.

The Parties shall not make unauthorized use of the trade name, trademark, copyright, patent, symbol, licenses, or designation belonging to the other party without prior approval and permission. In the event, the College or any of its personnel/ students/ faculty breach its confidentiality obligations or infringe the intellectual property of Movate, Movate shall have the right to pursue appropriate remedies available at law and shall be entitled to equitable relief. In addition, the College shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Movate, from and against all claims and all losses, liabilities, obligations, damages, expenses and costs (including without limitation reasonable legal fees) brought against or suffered by Movate or any of its respective officers, directors, employees, partners or agents, resulting from, arising out of or relating to breach of confidentiality obligations, applicable laws and regulations and infringement of intellectual property.

The College may have similar collaborations with other companies so long as Movate 's interests are not compromised, confidentiality of the knowhow and processes are maintained, the Pre-selected Students alone are put through Movate training curriculum and made available exclusively to Movate for its recruitment process.
- 12. The College shall take all necessary steps to safeguard the interest of Movate by avoiding any conflict of interest with other competing companies. Prior approvals need to be taken from Movate for any event involving the Pre-selected Students or the Movate CoE.
- **13.** Except as expressly stated in this MOU, there shall be no obligation on either of the Parties to compensate the other in any manner or any claim. However, the terms and the conditions in this MOU shall be kept confidential.
- **14.** The Parties agree that no party shall be held liable for any act or omission of the other party under this MOU.
- **15.** The Parties represent that they have the full power and authority to enter this MOU in general and none of the objects stipulated herein are against public policy.

- 17. The Parties agree to negotiate amendments to this MOU, if necessary, to meet the evolving requirements.

 Any amendment and / or modifications to the MOU will require written approval from both Parties.

The termination of this MOU shall not affect the implementation of the projects or programs established under it, prior to such termination or until such definitive agreement is agreed and executed between the Parties whichever is earlier. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, in the event of expiry or early termination of this MOU, College shall reimburse all expenses incurred by Movate in performing its obligations under this MOU till the effective date of termination.
- 19. Any dispute arising out of this MOU shall be at the first instance attempted to be settled amicably between the Parties within a period of 30 days. If the dispute is not resolved within 30 days from the date it first arose, or if either Party believes that it is unlikely to be resolved in this matter, any such dispute shall be finally referred to arbitration. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this MOU, or the breach thereof, shall be settled in accordance with Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996, and



judgment on the award rendered by the arbitrator may be entered in any court having jurisdiction. The arbitration shall be conducted by single arbitrator mutually appointed by the Parties. The seat of arbitration shall be Chennai, Tamil Nadu, India, and the arbitration shall be conducted in English language. In case, the dispute cannot be settled amicably, this MOU shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts at Chennai.

- 20. Force Majeure. Neither Party shall be liable for any loss, damage or penalty resulting from delays or failures in performance of their obligations under this MOU if the failure results from events beyond the reasonable control of either Party. WHEREAS,

- A Celonis is a world leading provider of process mining technology;
- B University is a world leading academic institution that endeavours to educate its students in the latest technology; and
- C Celonis and University wish to cooperate in the academic area through making available their technology, trainings and personnel and respectively adding such technology to the curriculum of academic activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Establishment of Academic Cooperation
- 1.1 The Parties herewith establish an academic co-operation for the Term (as defined below) and shall have the right to refer to each other as "Academic Co-operation Partners".

Except for the limited rights granted in this Agreement, all proprietary and intellectual property rights in the Celonis products, Celonis materials, and in the name, logo and other trademarks of Celonis are and shall be owned by and remain with Celonis. Neither Party shall use, register, nor attempt to register, any trade name, trademark, service mark, design or domain name which, in whole or in part, incorporates or is confusingly similar to any trademarks of the other Party.
- 4.4 Celonis Product Scripts and Schema. Celonis may make available to University as part of the Academic Products Celonis product-related scripts, schema and/or code that can be used to create process analysis implementations for the Celonis product platform (collectively, the "Celonis Schema"). Where Celonis Schema are made available to University, University is granted for the Term of this Agreement a limited, non-

exclusive, revocable license to use and modify the Celonis Schema for purposes of conducting internal training of its personnel and providing curricular activities on the Academic Products, and performing its other rights and obligations defined in this Agreement. University will be owner of all right, title and interest in and to any modifications University makes to the Celonis Schema, subject, always, to Celonis' underlying ownership interest in and to all of the Academic Products and Celonis materials from which University's modifications derive.

For clarity, if University or Academic Users utilize the Academic Products made available under this Agreement with any Personal Data, then Annex B (Data Processing Agreement) of Celonis' Cloud Services Agreement as referenced by the Academic Users Terms shall apply to provide Celonis and University's (respectively Academic User's) respective obligations with respect to the protection and security of such Personal Data. For purposes of this Agreement, (i) "Personal Data" means any data and information relating to an identified or identifiable living individual person as defined under applicable Data Protection Laws; and (ii) "Data Protection Laws" means all laws, rules, regulations, decrees, or other enactments, orders, mandates, or resolutions relating to privacy, data security, and/or data protection, and any implementing, derivative or related legislation, rule, and regulation as amended, extended, repealed and replaced, or re-enacted, as well as any applicable industry self-regulatory programs related to the collection, use, disclosure, and security of personal information.

6 Term and Termination

- The Agreement shall commence on the date of signature by both Parties (the "Effective Date") and shall continue in effect for a period of twenty-four (24) months (the "Initial Agreement Term"). It and shall thereafter, subjection to Section 6.2, automatically renew for additional twelve (12) months' terms each (each a "Renewal Agreement Term", the Initial Agreement Term and all Renewal Agreement Terms together, the "Agreement Term") unless terminated in accordance with the following provisions.

- 8.2 All Confidential Information supplied by the one Party to the other Party pursuant to this Agreement, together with all copies thereof, will remain the property of the disclosing Party. During the Term and after termination or expiration of the Agreement for any reason whatsoever, each party shall keep the other Party's Confidential Information confidential, not disclose any Confidential Information to third parties and not use the other party's Confidential Information for any purpose other than the performance of its obligations under the Agreement.

f) Faculty of NITW and VCE, Warangal will develop joint societal impact projects and collaborations with other external agencies/ R&D organizations/ Indian and overseas Educational Institutions.

5.0: ACADEMIC INTERACTIONS AND SUPPORT LEADING TO HIGHER QUALIFICATIONS

- a) As VCE, Warangal is well established autonomous Institute, and the majority of faculty members in VCE, Warangal are postgraduates and doctorates from premier institutes such as IITs, NITs, and Central Universities; NITW shall allow faculty members of VCE, Warangal to register for Ph.D. on part-time/external mode/full-time subject to their meeting the admission criteria and based on interview performance.

b) Faculty shall share articles, publications, scientific information, patents information, etc., for their academic needs and not for commercial purposes on mutual consent and case to case basis about revenue sharing and expenditure.

- a) Students of VCE, Warangal campus can visit NITW for 6 to 8 Weeks to do summer internship work under the guidance of the NITW faculty based on the availability. Students of NITW can visit VCE, Warangal campuses for their internships/miniprojects/projects under the guidance of VCE, Warangal faculty.
- b) Students of VCE, Warangal, and NITW can do final year project work based on mutual interest under the joint guidance of the faculty members from VCE, Warangal, and NITW.
- c) Faculty from NITW can visit VCE, Warangal, to teach a part of any course of the B.Tech. Program with prior permission from NITW. Emoluments shall be paid to the faculty as per the VCE, Warangal norms.




